

Subject: Exemption Notice Regarding Non-Hazardous Items

To Whom It May Concern:

It has been determined that this product does not require an SDS based on the following code section.

The Hazard Communication regulation, which requires the preparation of SDS for hazardous chemicals in the workplace, reads as follows:

## Title 29 Section 1910.1200 Hazard communication

(b)(6) This section does not apply to: (vii) Any drug, as that term is defined in the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 301 et seq.), when it is in solid, final form for direct administration to the patient (e.g., tablets or pills); drugs which are packaged by the chemical manufacturer for sale to consumers in a retail establishment (e.g., over-the-counter drugs); and drugs intended for personal consumption by employees while in the workplace (e.g., first aid supplies).
